

# Basic Rider Course - 2 -Fact Sheet

**How do I know I'm registered?** You will receive an e-mail from AIRS—could take up to 2 days.

**Where do I go?** Depends on the class location. The e-mail from AIRS has the correct location. The directions page also has additional information.

**Watson Street Range,** Directions Page has a google map. Might be very helpful to drive-by the range before your class date. Less stress than trying to find it on class day and being late, arrive in time..

PARK ON THE BLUE T- down by the conex and wood building, w/ front facing those two buildings.

**Apollo Street Range,** Directions Page has a google map. Might be very helpful to drive-by the range before your class date. Less stress than trying to find it on class day and being late, arrive in time..

PARK DOWN BY THE 40' TRAILER on the T's, w/ front facing the runway.

**When do I have to be there?** Check-In begins 15 minutes before class start time. **Don't be late!** *Class will start on time and late arrivals will not be allowed to attend.* **Arrive early enough to check-in and complete T-CLOCS.**

**What do I need to bring?** Answer on the FAQ Page.

**What do I need to wear?** Answer on the FAQ Page.

**I'm using my motorcycle (POM), are there special requirements when I use my POM?**

You must have a motorcycle license, or learner permit.

Have a full tank of gas.

Tires in good condition—not: bald, underinflated (*PSI per motorcycle owners manual*) and cord showing, or cleaned with armorall / tire shine

Strong battery—good charge.

Proper display of license plate—must be seen from 50' and have a white light.

All POM will have mirrors, mounted on both sides (per AR 385-10).

Motorcycle must pass T-CLOCS. Additional information concerning T-CLOCS on FAQ Page.

**How can I prepare myself for success?** Take the time and read: BRC-2 Page and FAQ Page - be ahead of the game. Start reading the BRC-2 Handbook (located on the BRC-2 Page).

**What if I can't make it? Something came up and I will not be able to attend.** If you will not be able to attend, use AIRS and cancel your registration, in order to allow another rider a chance to register.
